PSYCHIATRY RESIDENCY PROGRAM

Penn Highlands Healthcare Psychiatry Residency Program offers inpatient and outpatient training to prepare residents for career in Psychiatry (or Behavioral Health Medicine).

Supported by the LECOMT OPTI, ACGME accreditation and working in conjunction with Family Medicine Residency Program.

Penn Highlands Healthcare is a 6 hospital system with one mission to improve regional access to quality health care while supporting quality of life for our community members. We continue to build a culture of a Community teaching hospital maintaining a one on one training with attending physicians between 2 residency programs and graduate medical education students.

Penn Highlands offers a variety of inpatient and outpatient Behavioral Health Services to treat the unique Mental Health concerns of patients including children ages 5 and up, adolescents and teens, adults, and seniors. Services provided include but are not limited to:

- Detox for Substance abuse
- Electroconvulsive Therapy (ECT)
- Medication Management
- MH Assessment
- Outpatient Group Therapy
- Psychiatric Evaluations
- Psychological Assessment
- Behavioral Therapy, Individual Therapy, and Family Therapy
- Suicide Risk Assessment and prevention

Penn Highlands offers specialized inpatient programs operating 24/7 for children and adolescents, ages 5 to 18, who are exhibiting behavioral problems impairing their ability to function in the home and/ or school. Inpatient child and adolescent services are offered at Penn Highlands DuBois.

Adult inpatient services offers treatment of emotional and behavioral difficulties experienced by individuals 18 years and older. Adult inpatient services are offered at Penn Highlands Brookville, Penn Highlands DuBois, and Penn Highlands Huntingdon.

Geriatric services treats patients 55 years and older dealing with mental health disorders or emotional breakdowns. Inpatient services are offered at Senior Transitions at Penn Highlands Brookville, Bright Horizons Center for Emotional Wellness at Penn Highlands Clearfield and Penn Highlands DuBois.

Outpatient services are designed to relieve emotional and personal distress for patients of all ages through counseling therapies, psychological assessment, psychiatry evaluation, and medication management.

Penn Highlands Behavioral Health Services is backed by all the advanced services and specialties of Penn Highlands DuBois, one of the region's top hospitals. This places our patients in close proximity for routine and emergency diagnosis and multidisciplinary medical care.

EXPANDING BEHAVIORAL HEALTH HOSPITAL – COMPLETION IN 2022

To better address the Mental Health needs in the area Penn Highlands DuBois is expanding to create a 126 bed campus providing a comprehensive continuum of behavioral health services. The new facility will offer care to patients with dual diagnosis of mental health disorders and substance abuse disorders, as well as drug and alcohol detox and rehabilitation.

New Features include:

- A walk-in urgent care center specific to behavioral health issues offering immediate care with referral to follow-up inpatient or outpatient services as needed.
- Expanded Outpatient behavioral Health program
- Child/Adolescent behavioral Health unit, with extended acute care unit
- Expanded Adult Behavioral Health Units
- New dual diagnosis unit for patients who need behavioral health services as well as drug and alcohol detox and rehabilitation.
