Non-Surgical Orthopedic Care

Whether your bone or joint pain is due to an injury, arthritis or just common wear and tear, it is reassuring to know that not all orthopedic conditions require surgery. There are many conservative treatments, such as medication and physical therapy, that can reduce pain and swelling. Often, your

primary care physician will recommend trying these treatments for several weeks. If they do not help your condition, you may then be referred to an orthopedic surgeon to evaluate your surgical options.

Sports Medicine

Penn Highlands expert sports medicine physicians treat all types of activity-related injuries and musculoskeletal conditions. They provide fast and accurate diagnoses and advanced therapies, including injections, physical therapy and minimally invasive surgery. The sports medicine physicians evaluate a patient's strength, flexibility and balance to assess whether an underlying condition is increasing the risk for injury or reinjury, and work to create a plan to help prevent future sports injuries.
